Committee Business

1. An election was held and new members unanimously approved. Sue Redington will be president and Robyn Cash will be secretary. New members are as follows Heather Fisher and Diana Totland.
 2. Much discussion on the proposed boundary changes by Jordan School District. The boundary maps were explained. With the addition of approx. 200 students the concerns of bussing, adding portable classrooms, car pool traffic, playground space per child and classroom sizes were addressed. Colleen Wheeler explained that no services will be lost to any student with this change, but we will be able to have more aids and teacher helps due to increased funding.
 3. Issue of how to help new families coming into Rosamond boundaries can feel included. Possible student lead tour school, field trips provided to incoming students, and web site updates discussed. PTA will work with the blog and Facebook to invite new families to our school for events that will be determined at a later time. We discussed inviting new students to our spring carnival in the spring.
 4. Elizabeth Bleak reviewed the success of the Road Runner Rally. The Council supplied the snacks to the school children. It was mentioned that we need to increase the number of snacks we have to include the younger siblings of the school children.
 5. A new task from the district is for the committee to approve and help revise the Code of Conduct for Rosamond. It was determined that Colleen Wheeler will work on a simple to understand, kid friendly wording Code of Conduct and will be assisted by volunteer's. Sue Redington and Robyn Cash offered to help. A time will be decided later.
 6. Colleen Wheeler explained the new report card levels. This new reading will assign a number to the children's "independent reading" level not assisted or prompted level. Parents will see this number can drop, sometimes 3 levels. Parents need to be aware that this is only a different way to test and should not be seen as a setback. The school will be sending out letters with the report cards.
 7. Meeting dates are set for the year 11/29/17, 1/10/19, 3/14/19. We will meet on May 23, 2019 only if needed.
 8. The Council unanimously approved to adjourn the meeting.
