Committee Business:

- Candie reviewed 2022-23 Land trust plan report. We ended up in the red about \$13.208.42. It is now
  required that the budget for Land trust now has to be stricter and more specific than it was in the past.
  (This change is not related to us going in the red) We spent money mainly on Walk to read and
  technology. We didn't spend money on software. Candie also reported on the school goals. We
  exceeded the RISE goal. The goal was to increase it by 3%. In English we went from 46% to 51 % and
  Math 49% to 55%.
- 2. PTC is next week, Wednesday and Thursday. It has worked great to have older grades in the library and younger grades in the cafeteria.
- 3. For next year, as of now, we will be having AM, PM and all-day kindergarten as an option. All day can have 22 students to be effective. So far 35 students are enrolled next year and 60% want all day.
- 4. Enrollment has slowly gone down. Overall, the district is not growing as much.
- 5. We need to make sure volunteers are getting background checks and not waiting until the day before.
- 6. New district policy D200 concerning guest speaker request form. Guest speakers need to sign a form on what can and cannot be discussed in class. Teachers need to notify parents of guest speakers.
- 7. District is updating safety drills, protocol and training. There is a new drill each month. Last month was a fire drill. This month the drill is "hold", something happening in the hall but not serious. Council discussed having the administration send a follow up email after drills so parents can discuss with their students.
- 8. Next meeting dates are March 19 and May 7.
- 9. Last meeting minutes reviewed. Heather motioned and Tara seconded to approve. Vote unanimously.
- 10. Abbie motion to adjourn meeting, Tara second and voted unanimously.
