3. Student / Teacher absentee rates: January was a tough month for teachers and students. There were a lot of call-outs and a lot of students out of the building. The District's decision to move to virtual learning was very helpful because we were consistently seeing 7-8 teachers out every day (due to sickness) when cases were very high. Currently we have about 12-13% of students absent daily. But attendance is improving as Covid cases lower.

Many classrooms are continuing their acts of kindness because they remembered that it's important to ALWAYS be kind – not just during the week to try and earn a party.
